Make-up Exams and Quizzes: No make-up exams or quizzes will be given. The math department policy for a missed exam is that, if you can justify the absence to the satisfaction of your instructor, then your grade on the relevant portion of the final exam will be substituted for the missing grade. Typically, you will not be allowed to make up more than one exam this way. If you cannot justify your absence from an exam, then you will receive a grade of zero for that exam.
